KNITTING 101:

Saturdays, July 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd and 29th, from 1:30 - 3

\$20 per session PLUS supplies.

Learn to knit. This class is for absolute beginners. Don't know a knitting needle from a pine needle? No problem! You'll learn the most basic stitch, the garter stitch, and start knitting a simple scarf. Then, you can learn how to cast on (putting stitches on the needles) and bind off (taking stitches off the needle). Come to one or more and pay as you go.

KID KNIT:

Does your child want to learn to knit? Let him or her explore the wonders of fiber and color at *Knit Locally*. Our instructor will help him or her to learn the most basic knit stitch and knit a simple garter stitch scarf. Come to one or more and pay as you go.

Socks, socks, sock....everyone wears them and you can't have enough of them. Socks are the most portable of all projects and the perfect travel project. Plus, once you've experienced the delight and comfort of wearing your own, hand-knit socks - you won't ever want to wear store-bought socks again. During this 4-part class, you will learn the basics of simple sock construction (top down on double pointed needles) and complete either one or both socks. You must know the basics of knitting, including: cast on/off, knit/purl, increase/decrease and will learn to knit on double pointed needles. Come to one or all and pay as you go.

KNITTING IN THE ROUND:

Know how to knit and purl, but the thought of knitting on circular needles has your brain spinning in circles? Overcome your fear of circular needles and learn to knit in the round while you start a simple winter hat. You'll be a pro in no time and can start churning out these great holiday gifts.

Learn a new way of knitting - continental knitting. Continental knitters insist it is faster, more efficient and easier on the hands. This style of knitting enables you to knit more efficiently than "throwing" (the English/American style of knitting) in which you hold the yarn in your right hand. With the more concise and fluid motion used in continental knitting, you will increase your efficiency while reducing wrist fatigue. This method is perfect for crocheters who want to learn to knit as well as experienced English/American knitters who want to learn a new technique.
